Show Rules and Conditions of Entry

- 1. The show will be conducted under AQHA rules. The judge's decision is final.
- 2. The AQHA reserves the right to swab for drugs at random without prior notice.
- 3. These rules are subject to change at the discretion of the Executive Committee.
- 4. Horses must be registered with their appropriate breed societies for approved classes and proof of registration should be available upon request.
- 5. Amateurs will be subject to AQHA rules and must include a copy of their current permit from their respective association with their entry form.
- 6. Youth age to be taken from 1st August. Youth classes will be combined if there are insufficient entries.
- 7. The committee reserves the right to change the order of events before or during the show. It is the responsibility of the competitor to be aware of any changes.
- 8. The committee, its affiliates and sponsors will not be held responsible for any injury incurred, damage to or loss of goods. All competitors compete at their own risk.
- 9. There will be a Disputes Committee consisting of the Show Manager, a Committee Member and one Contestant.
- 10. The Southern NSW Quarter Horse Association Committee reserves the right to prohibit any person from showing or attending any horse in the show ring, and to remove any person or horse from the grounds without being liable for compensation.
- 11. Competitors/participants at any event run by Southern NSW Quarter Horse Association have a responsibility to ensure the welfare of their horses and at all times to treat their horses humanely and with dignity, respect and compassion. Competitors/participants are to conduct themselves in a professional manner and act with integrity in all dealings with the Affiliate and other competitors. To uphold the rules and regulations of the Southern NSW Quarter Horse Association and the AQHA at all times. Competitors/participants are to demonstrate good sportsmanship at all times, showing respect for your fellow competitors and officials, following the rules and to treat people the way you yourself wish to be treated.
- 12. All youth competing or taking part in an AQHA approved event, must have written permission from their parent/guardian to be at that event as a contestant or participant and in the case of a contest, the parent/guardian must also sign the entry form. All youth competing or taking part in an AQHA approved event must be in the care of a responsible adult who is in attendance for the duration of that event, whilst the youth is in attendance at that event.
- 13. Open Walk & Trot and Walk & Jog classes are to be ridden in the correct bit for the horse's age and either one or two handed according to the bit and AQHA rules.
- 14. A beginner Youth or Adult is a competitor that satisfies the following criteria
 - Has not won ANY performance event in an Open Amateur or Youth class at any A or AA Class SNSWQHA or
 equivalent show where there were three or more entrants in a class per category. E.g. If a competitor wins
 open or amateur halter at an approved show they will still be eligible to compete in beginner ridden
 classes.
 - Has not won three times in that particular beginner event where there were three or more competitors.
 After a competitor has obtained three wins they are no longer eligible to participate in that particular beginners' class.
 - Has not won a beginner Youth or Adult Annual High Point award.
 - After a beginner has obtained wins as above they are no longer eligible to participate in beginner classes
 in subsequent years. The competitor may continue to show in Beginner classes until the end of the points
 year.
 - Notwithstanding the above SNSWQHA Committee reserves the right to use their discretion in determining the beginner status of any competitor.
 - Beginner Riders can ride 'two handed' regardless of the age of the horse or the type of bit used.
 - Beginner Riders are not to compete on colts or stallions
 - The SNSWQHA committee highly recommend that all beginner competitors wear a helmet at all times when riding, in both the arena events and warm up areas, for both Adult and Youth riders.
- 15. **Green Horse Classes** A Green Horse is for Junior and Senior horses that are not ready to compete in Open or point scoring classes.
 - They can be shown in snaffle or shank bits no matter of age.
 - A Green horse cannot be shown in Open or other point scoring ridden classes.
 - A Green Horse cannot be shown by a Beginner Rider.
- A Green Horse can be shown in Novice Amateur, Amateur, Select Amateur and Youth in hand classes

- 16. No alcohol or cigarettes are allowed in or can be consumed in the marshalling areas, working areas or show pen/contest areas.
- 17. Horses must be under control at all times.
- 18. HIGH POINT Categories and Rules High Point prizes are awarded when competitors attend 50% of shows. The Committee reserves the right to determine prizes.
